

# Auger Tube Cutting Instructions

Starting from the end of the auger tube ( Dia. 1) measure 12" back. Cut 2/3 of the top of the tube away it should look like (dia. 2.) Then you slip the auger tube into the boot and drill 2 --5/16" holes through the tube and boot about 8" apart and bolt the tube to the boot using 1/4" X 1" Carrage bolts. The Nylon bushing is used at the tail of the auger to help hold it. You want to mount the nylon bushing so there is about 1/4" clearence under the auger.
